## Call for Papers and Posters

This will be a free two day event including the opportunity to present posters and/or papers on the subject of lithic materials and identification. It is meant to be a relatively informal gathering with plenty of time to visit and share lithic samples and artifacts.

If you want to give a paper or poster, or have a display we need to know by **February 9, 2018**. We will have a laptop and digital projector available.

#### Papers

Deadline to submit a brief description is Friday, February 9, 2018. Papers should be approximately 15 minutes in length with additional time scheduled for discussion after each paper.

#### Posters

Deadline to submit a brief description is Friday February 9, 2018. Any reasonable poster size is OK.

#### Displays

Deadline to submit brief description is Friday, February 9, 2018. Let us know if you will need electrical power for your display. Building will be locked overnight for storage purposes.

#### Lithic Materials Exchange

If you are planning on bringing a large amount of material please let us know by February 9, 2018 so that we can be sure and arrange enough table space. Additional details to follow.
